Koolie Pedigree Assurance Program Test Form

The Koolie Club of Australia has a Koolie Pedigree Assurance Program which requires those Koolies entered being D.N.A. profiled and health tested. D.N.A. samples may only be collected by a Koolie Club collector or by a veterinarian. Only those Koolies collected this way who are also micro-chipped or tattooed, verified by the collector and recorded in the register will have their registration number appended with D. Koolies tested for breed purity will have the results reflected with a level rating appended to the registration number. Koolies tested may also be entered on the KCA web database.

Koolies not micro-chipped or tattooed may still be tested but results will not be endorsed by the K.C.A. and may only be used for a breeder's own purpose and not publicised in any way.

Koolies not registered with the Koolie Club of Australia may be tested, but if registered with another society the relevant registration details must be recorded here. Owners must be current members of the Koolie Club of Australia.

Collection Instructions

- Try not to feed or the animal for 15 minutes prior to collection.
- Do not collect shortly after drinking.
- Samples can be collected from animals of any age.
- Although human contamination does not affect the sample or the result, it is recommended to wear gloves when taking the sample. This is more necessary for vets who are exposed to animals on a more frequent basis thus making cross contamination more of a possibility.
- You need to collect 2 swab samples from each animal for each test ie DNA profile & health testing = 2 swabs, Koolie Breed Purity Test = 2 swabs.
- Open the swab packaging and remove the sterile swab holding onto the plastic shaf.
- Insert the tip of the swab into the cheek area of the animal.
- To ensure sufficient capture epithelial (cheek) cells from the animal pinch the cheek around the swab and gently swirl (twist) the swab around the pinched cheek.
- Swirl for approximately 5 seconds.
- Place the swab back into its original packaging and repate the procedure using the second swab on the opposite cheek are.
